

Link-Up & Lifeline Get Connected

You May Qualify For Discounted Telephone Service

You may be eligible for greatly reduced local phone line installation and a credit each month to lower the cost of your local phone service. The Link-UP and Lifeline programs provide these benefits to eligible individuals and families.

What are Lifeline & Link-Up?

Lifeline and Link-Up are federal programs offering telephone discounts to low-income consumers in all U.S. states and territories. Those who qualify may receive discounts of up to \$16.50 on telephone hook-up charges (Link-Up) and \$8.25 on monthly basic phone service (Lifeline).

To determine your eligibility for Link-Up and Lifeline and to enroll in these programs, contact your local business office.

- Medicaid • Food Stamps
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance (LIHEAP)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Public Housing
- Senior Citizen Low-Income Discount Plan Offered By Your Local Gas Or Power Company
